LWML (**Lutheran Women Missionary League**) ~~ Watch this location for LWML updates. Results and fun facts from the 2024 LWML Michigan District Convention will be posted over the next few weeks. To start, here's a summary of the grants that were awarded. LWML grants are funded by Mite Box collections from congregations throughout the state. These small boxes of loose change become mighty when gathered together!

- The Michigan LWML met their mite goals: a total of \$386,000 was collected with \$300,000 awarded in grants! A portion of the Michigan total will be submitted to the national LWML for additional grant awards next year.
- · 14 grants were fully funded and 1 was partially funded! These are the organizations that received grants this year:
- 1. The Love of Christ for Pity's Sake Orphan Grain Train, Michigan -- \$25,000
- 2. Filling Pulpits by Providing Scholarships for Michigan Men in Synodical Seminaries -- \$25,000.00

- 4. ASL (American Sign Language) Storybook Apps, St. Martin Lutheran School for the Deaf -- \$17,950.00
- 5. Scholarships for Female Students Studying to be a Deaconess or Professional Church Worker -- \$20,000.00
- 6. Proclaiming Christ to Those Living in Visual Darkness -- \$25,000.00
- 7. Welcoming All God's Children Lutheran Special Education Ministries -- \$25,000.00
- 8. Be Thou My Vision, Eyeglass Evangelism Outreach MOST Ministries -- \$25,000.00
- 9. Powering the Expansion of Franklin Avenue Mission Mobile Ministries -- \$25,000.00
- 10. New Shepherds for South Sudan -- \$18,000.00
- 11. Caribbean Children's Foundation Medical Clinic for Ile-a-Vache, Haiti -- \$25,000.00
- 12. Afghan Refugee Ministry St. Michael Lutheran Church, Portage -- \$25,000.00
