WHAT'S NEXT FOR OPEN ARMS UPDATE!

- 1. Interviews at Open Arms with the two Pastor recently added to the Call list are planned for June 20th and 26th. If one or both of these Pastors is recommended and approved by the Board of Directors, a Voters Meeting will be held in July to consider extending a Call for one of them to serve at Open Arms. <u>Tentative Date for the Voters Meeting is July 13th after the service.</u>
- 2. Leaders from Open Arms met with the Pastor and leaders from St. Michael in Wayne on Wednesday to explore possible partnership with both churches working together. St. Michael is ready to help Open Arms in any way they can. A second meeting is being planned for some time in the Fall when Open Arms has a better idea of what those needs might be.
- 3. Approval for a Special Ministry Pastor (SMP) to serve at Open Arms is still being considered and may be brought up at the Voters Meeting in July. Congregation approval and support for an SMP candidate is a required step to apply for an SMP pastor. Applications for SMP candidates have to be submitted by August 31st.
